Suspension Notice

It has come to our attention that on 10-11-2025, some students of 3rd and 5th semester engaged in misbehaviour and physical assault with 1st semester student inside campus. Such actions are a clear violation of the code of conduct (As per AICTE notified Regulation for prevention and prohibition of ragging vide No. 27-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 and UGC letter (No. F. 1021/2009 (Anti Ragging) "In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the University Grants Commission has framed "UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009" which have been notified on 4th July, 2009 in the Gazette of India",) and create an inappropriate and disruptive environment within the college campus.

Based on application and observation of present faculty member and supervisor at the incidence, the anti ragging Committee has decided to suspend involved students from all academic and non-academic activities with immediate effect. This suspension will remain in effect until 28-11-2025. The names of involved students are:
